This pack contains early learning printables to use with your toddler or preschooler when studying about astronauts. We used the book [On the Moon](#) by Anna Milbourne and Benji Davies and absolutely loved it!! I would highly recommend printing the activities from this set onto cardstock so that they are sturdier for younger hands.
