
Printables for this bonus pack include:


- Beginning sound cards

- Letter S is for soil word tracing and coloring sheet



Print, laminate and cut out. Have your child either clip a clothespin to the correct beginning letter sound or use a dry erase marker to circle the correct letter. Key: rain, soil, cultivator, wheelbarrow.


## Help the flower grow!

Discard pile


