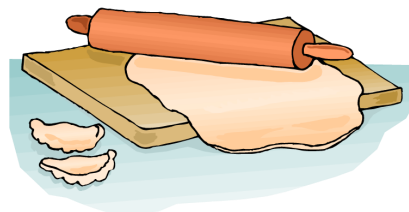
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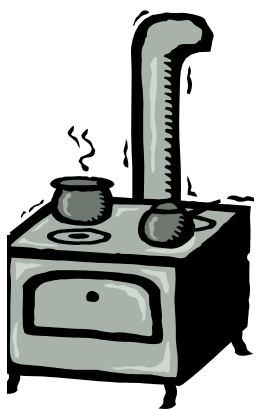
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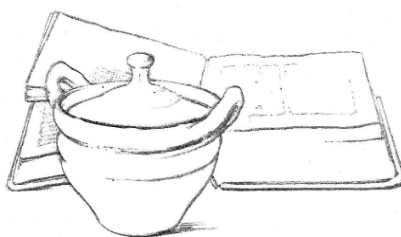
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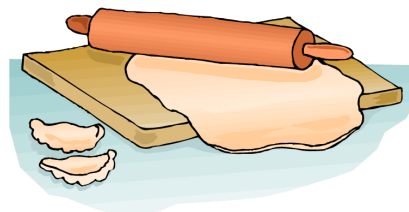
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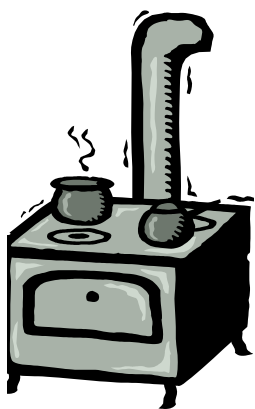
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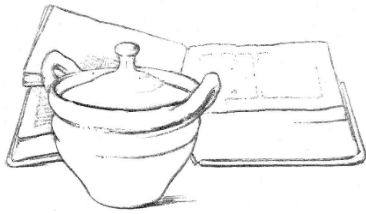
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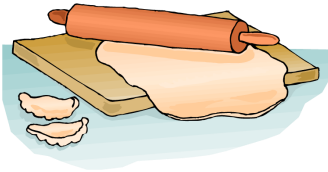
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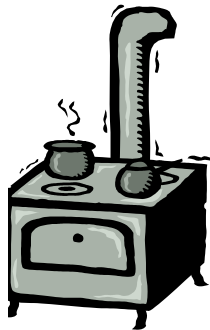
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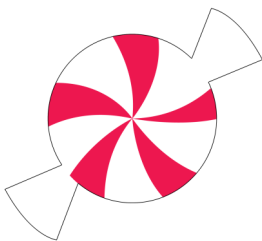
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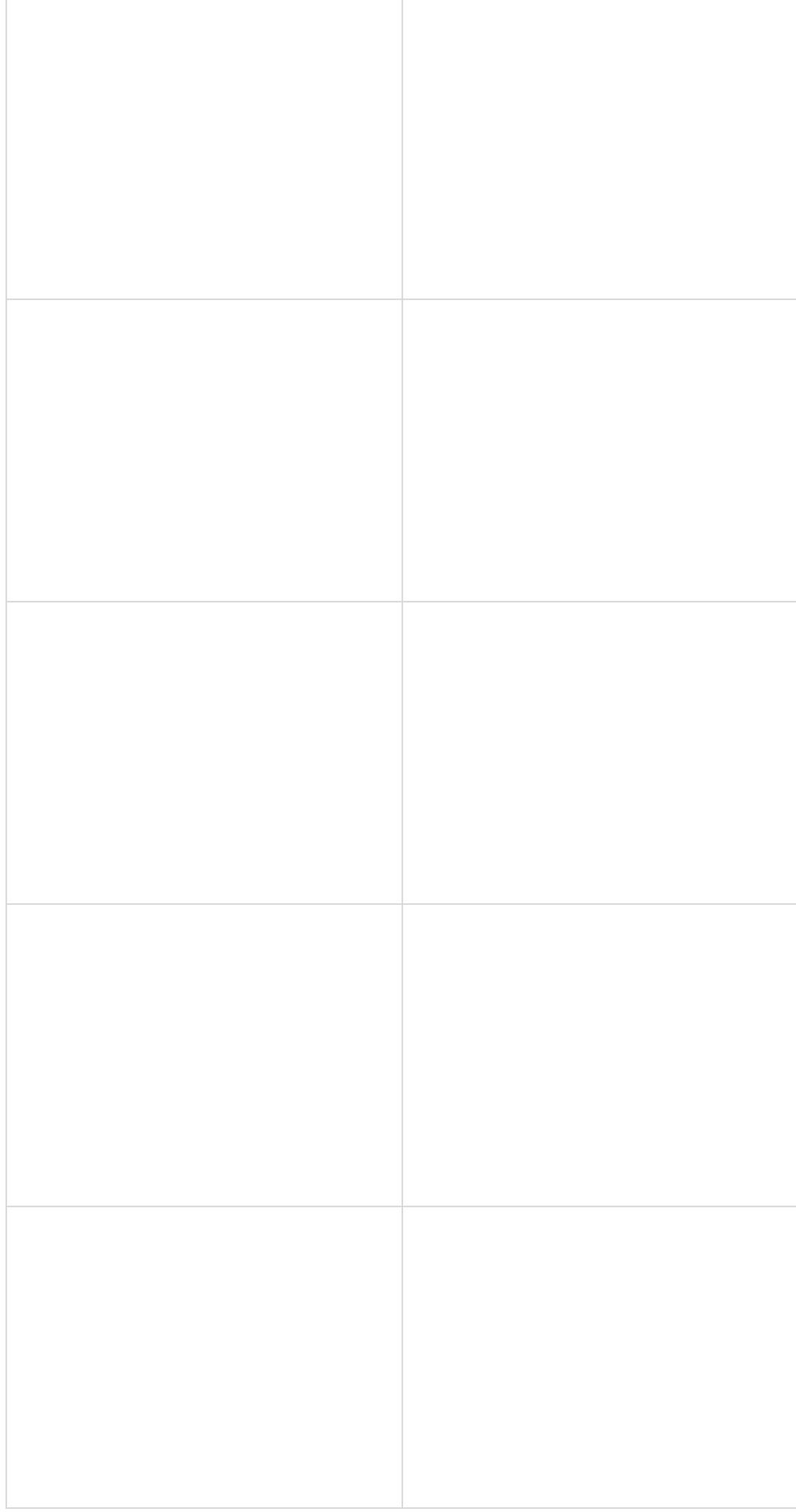
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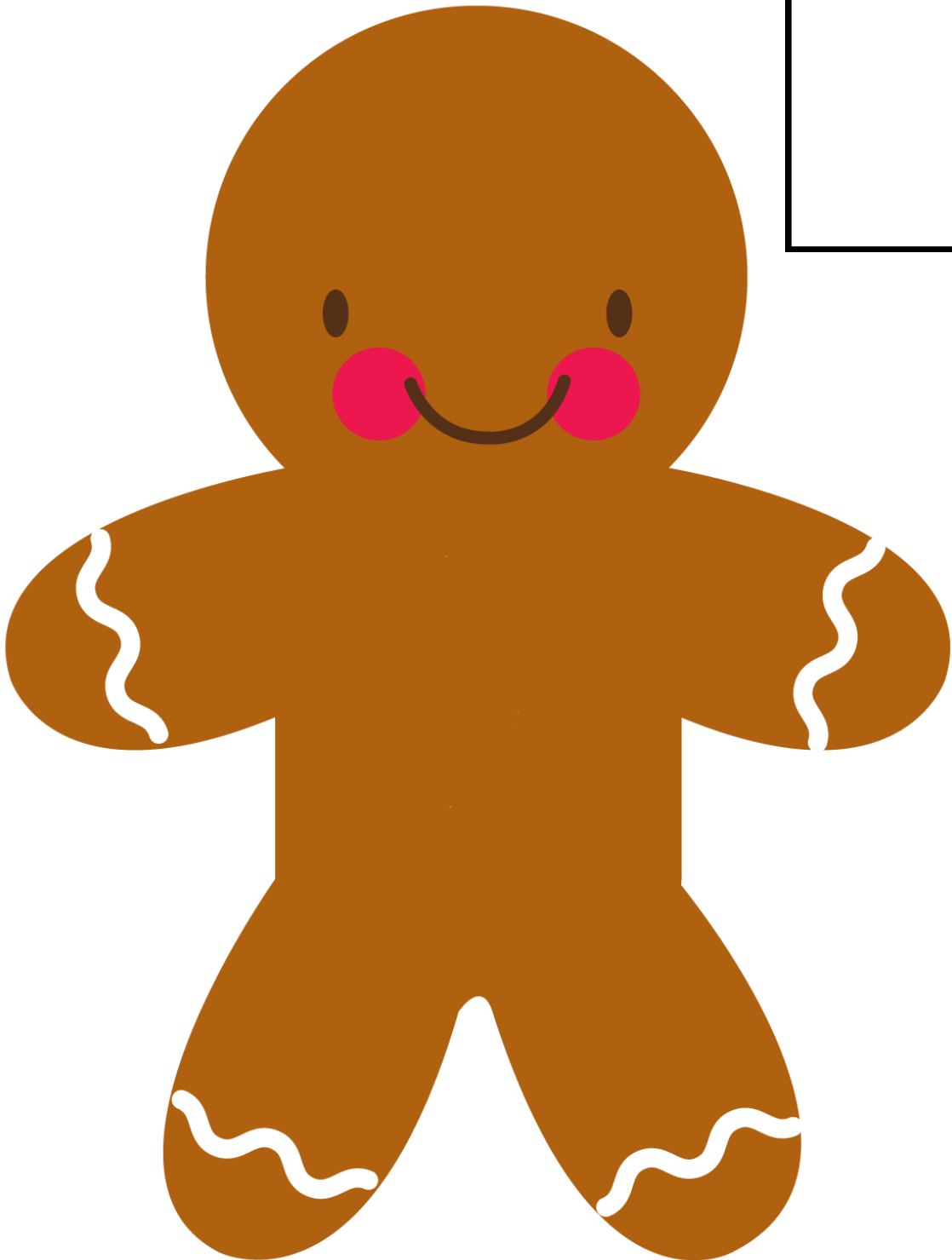
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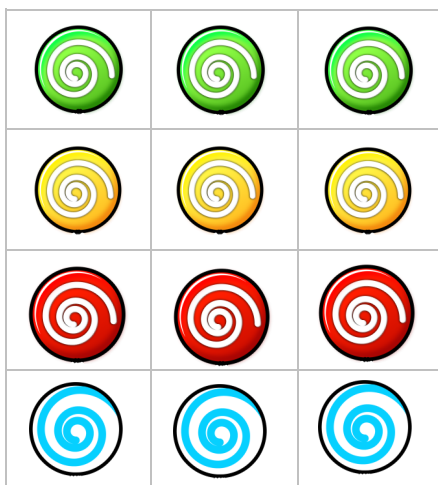
Cut out and tape together the two strips to make one long patterning board. Use the images on the previous to work on different patterns with your child!

Next, eat his right leg.

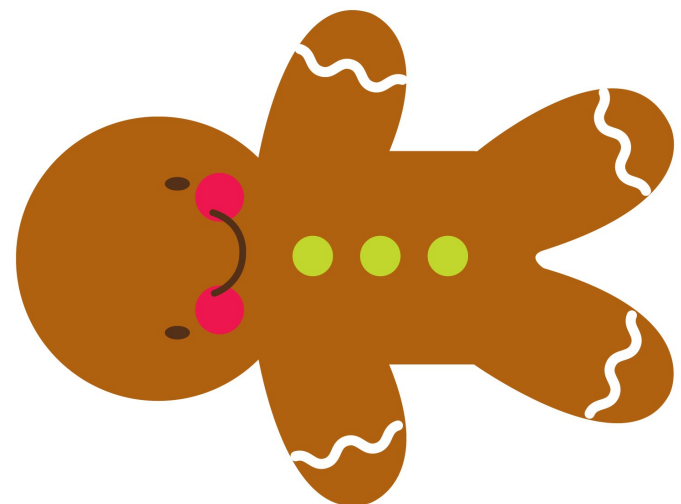
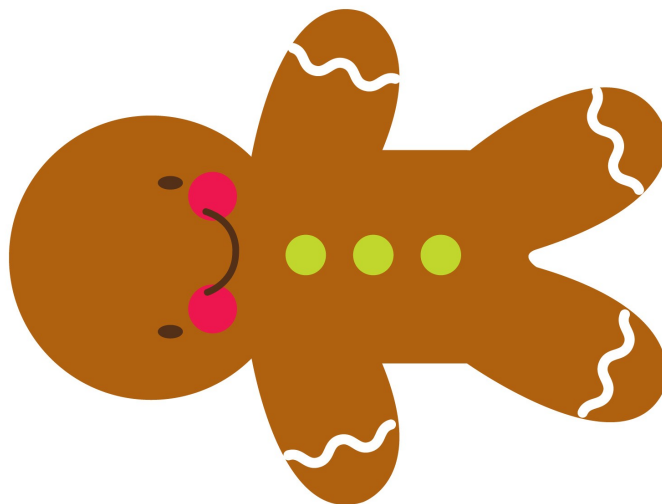
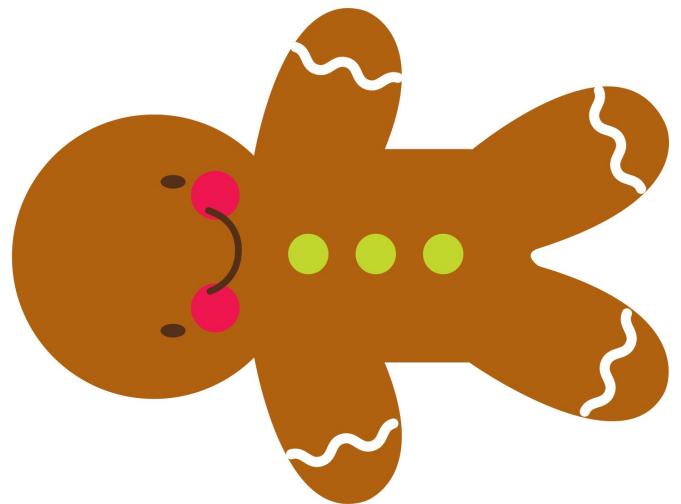
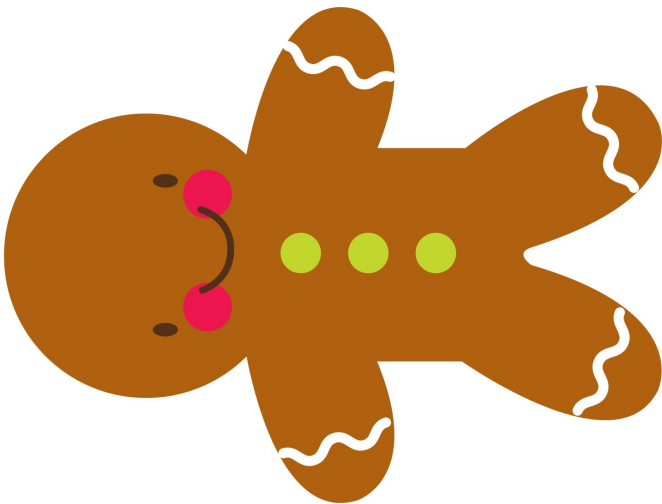
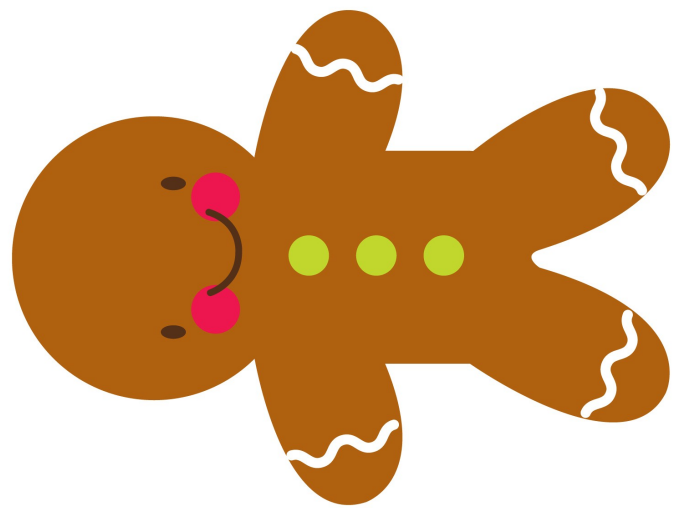
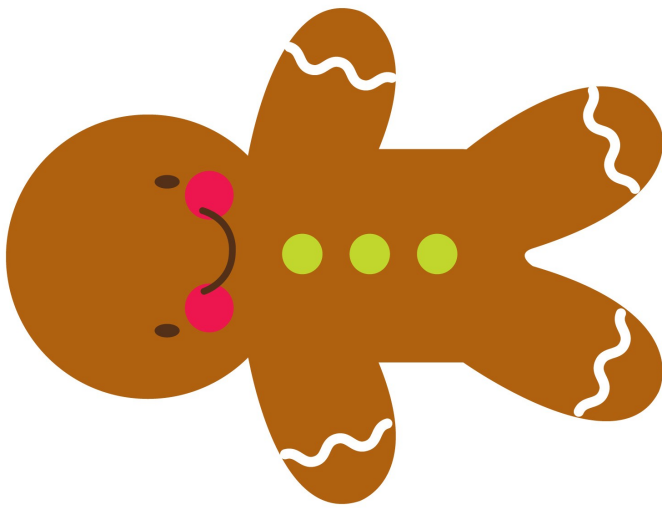
Then, eat his left arm.

Munch on his right arm.

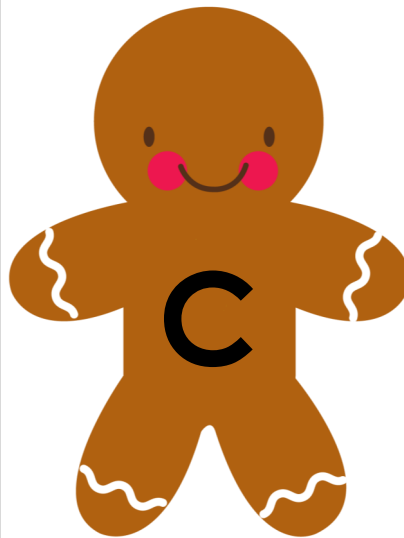
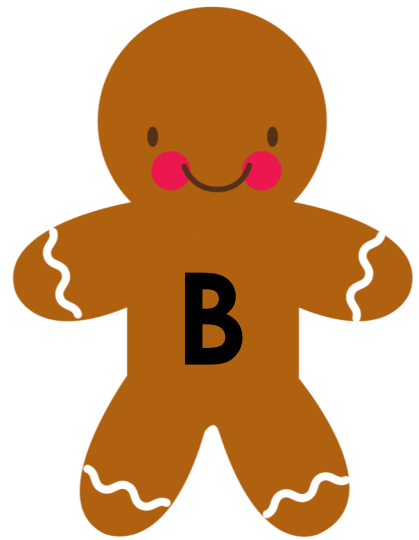
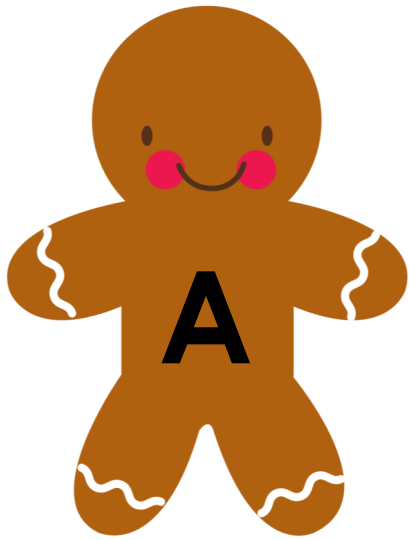
Take a bite from his head.

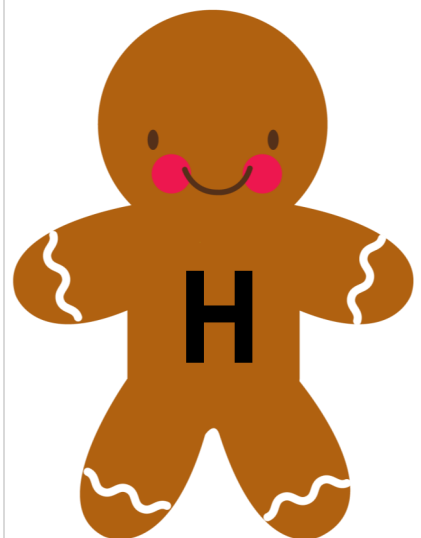

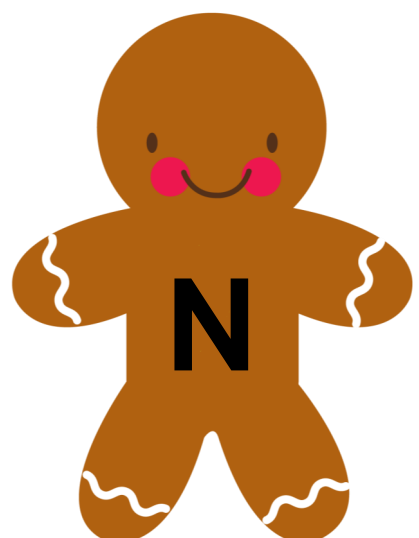
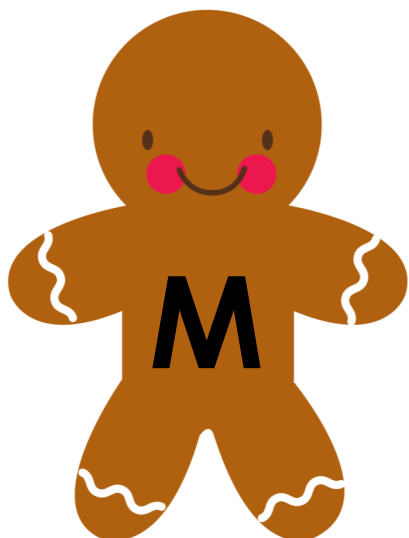
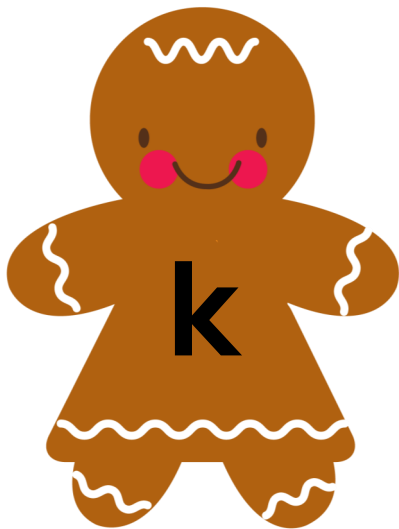
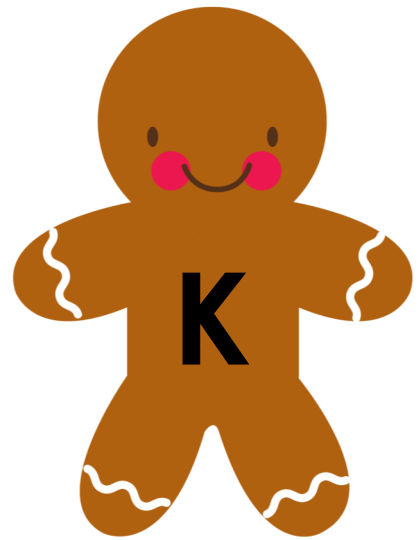
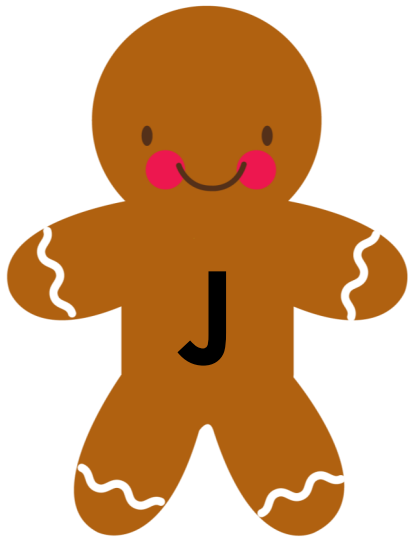
Gobble up any crumbs!

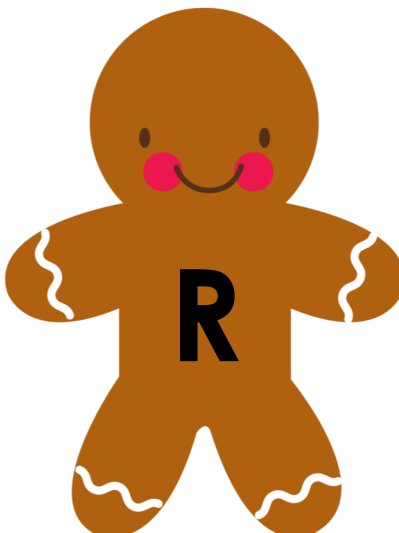
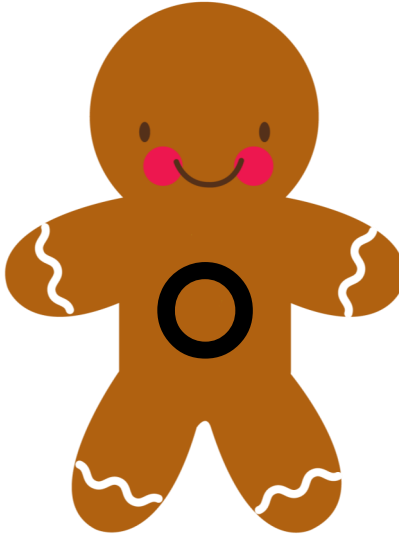


Use these gingerbread babies in the little book. Tear off the pieces needed to match the story. Use the leftover pieces as 'crumbs' at the end!

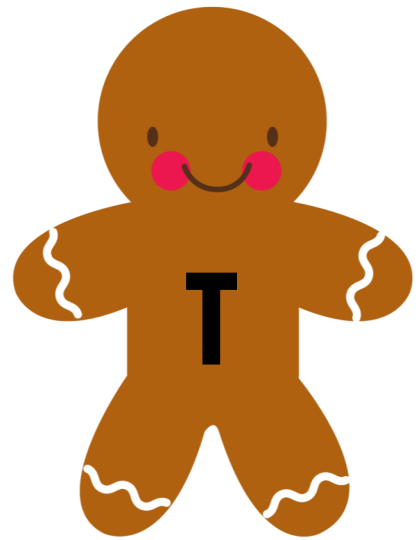


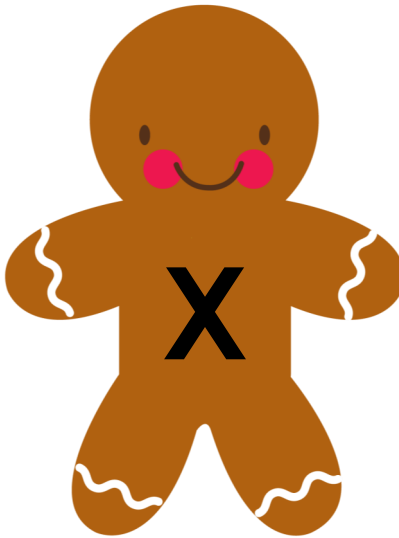












Use the upper and lowercase letter cards to play a matching game with your child. You can also use them to spell your child's name, put in correct ABC order or anything else you would like!

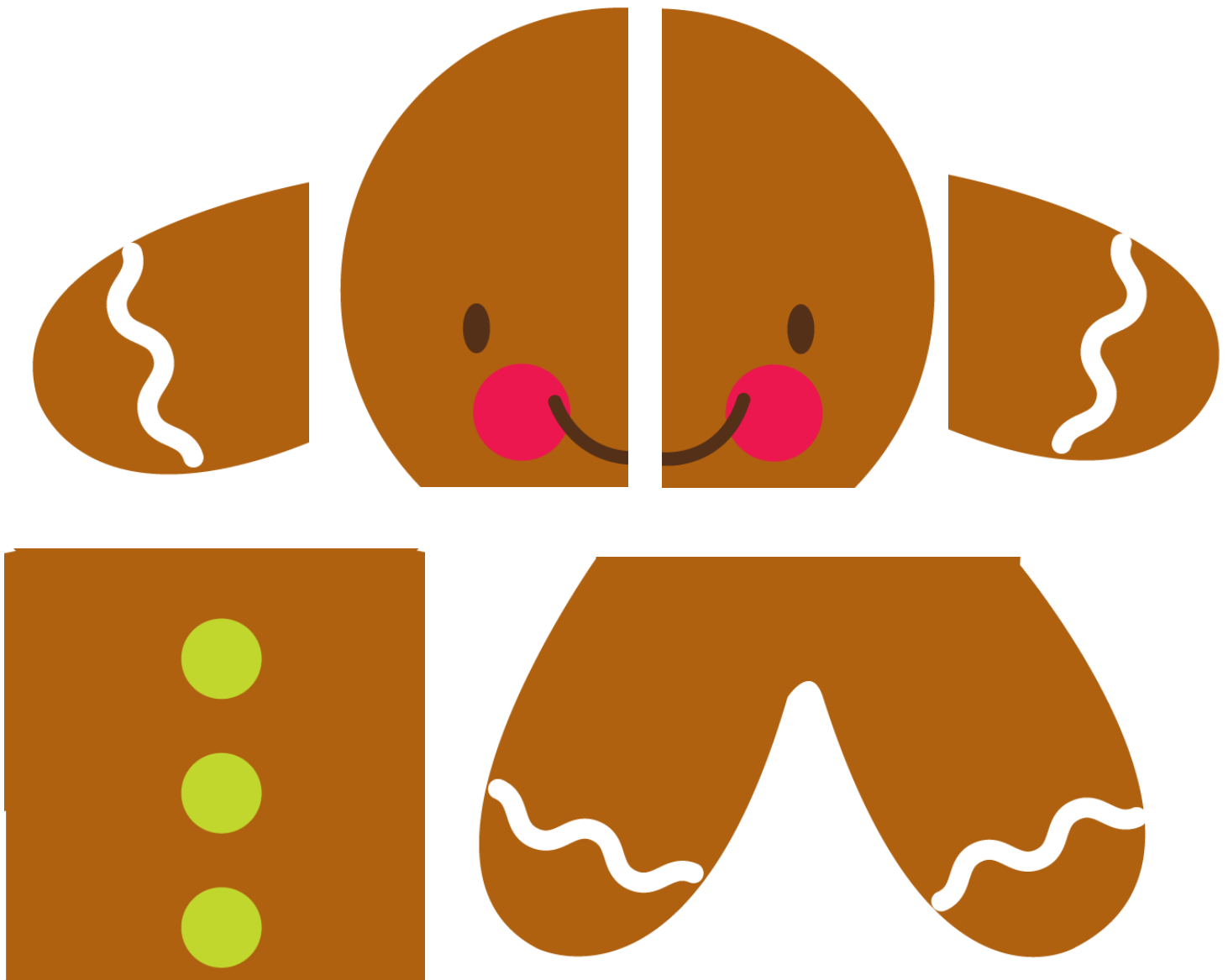


Hide the gingerbread baby behind one of the houses. Can you find him?

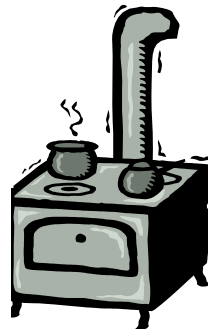
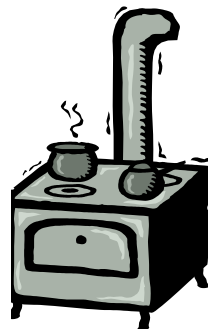
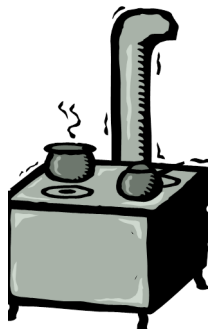
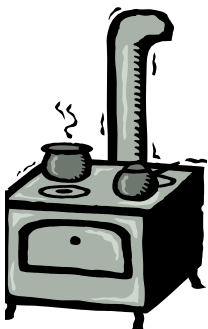
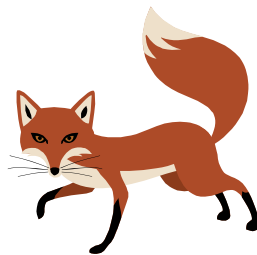
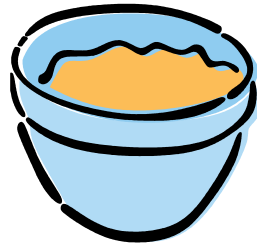
# Gingerbread Baby Puzzle

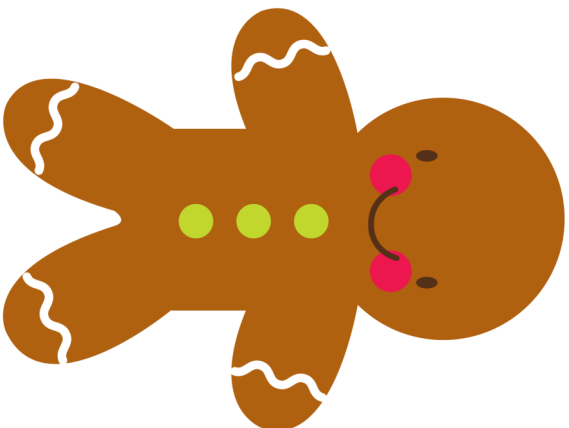
Print out the pieces onto cardstock and have fun piecing together the gingerbread boy! For added fun, you can roll a die to pick a piece. For example:
