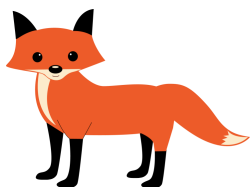
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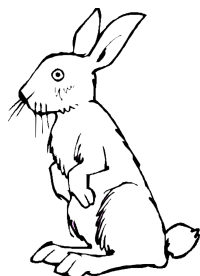


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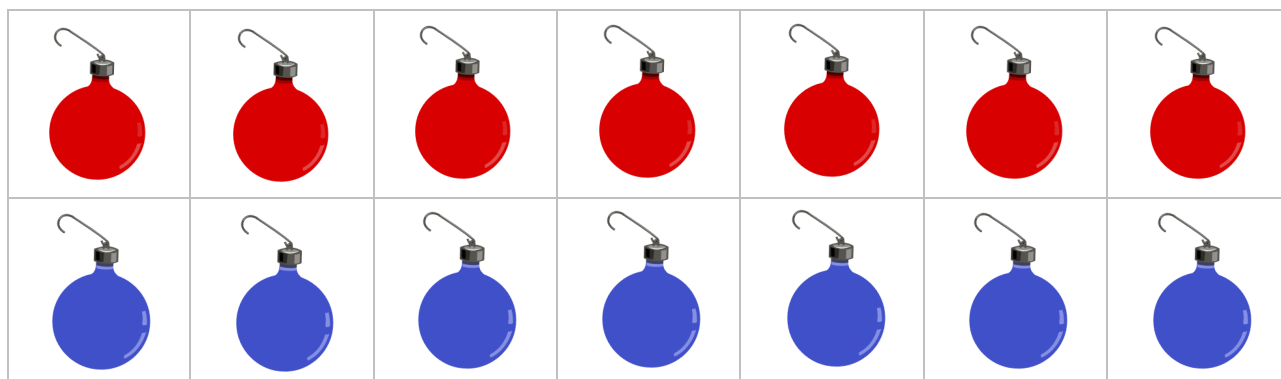


Ornament Addition

The maid took the 1st top.

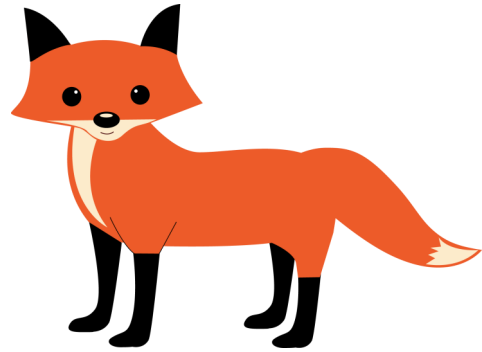


The gardener took the 2nd top.

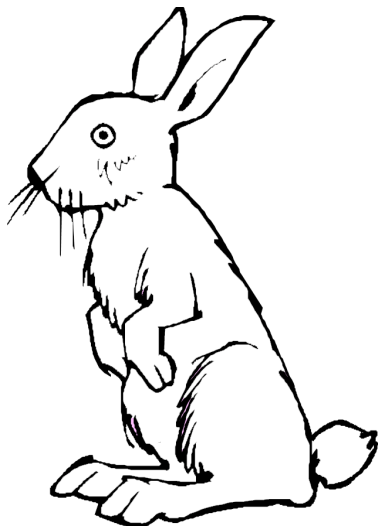


The bear took the 3rd top.

The fox took the 4th top.

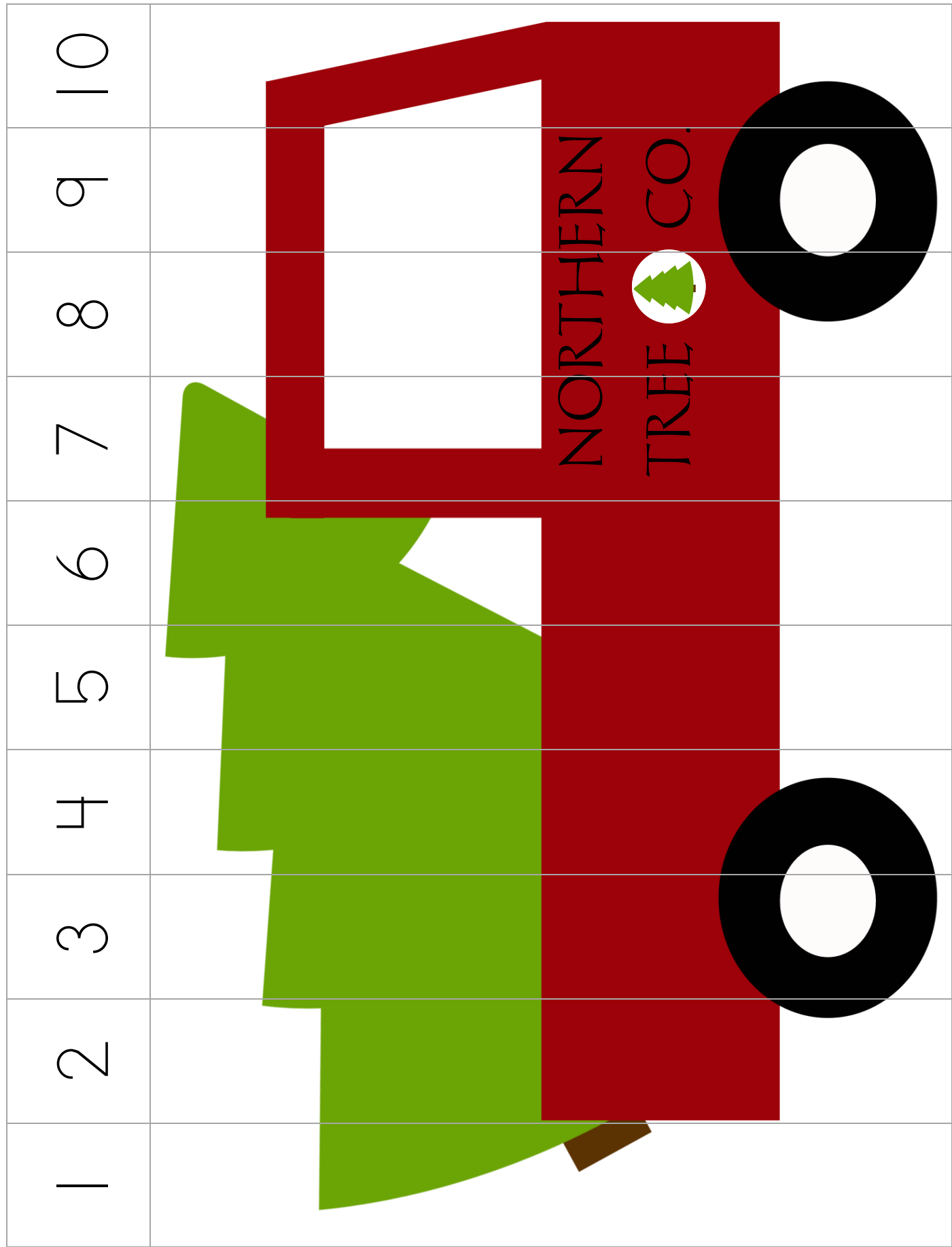


The rabbit took the 5th top.



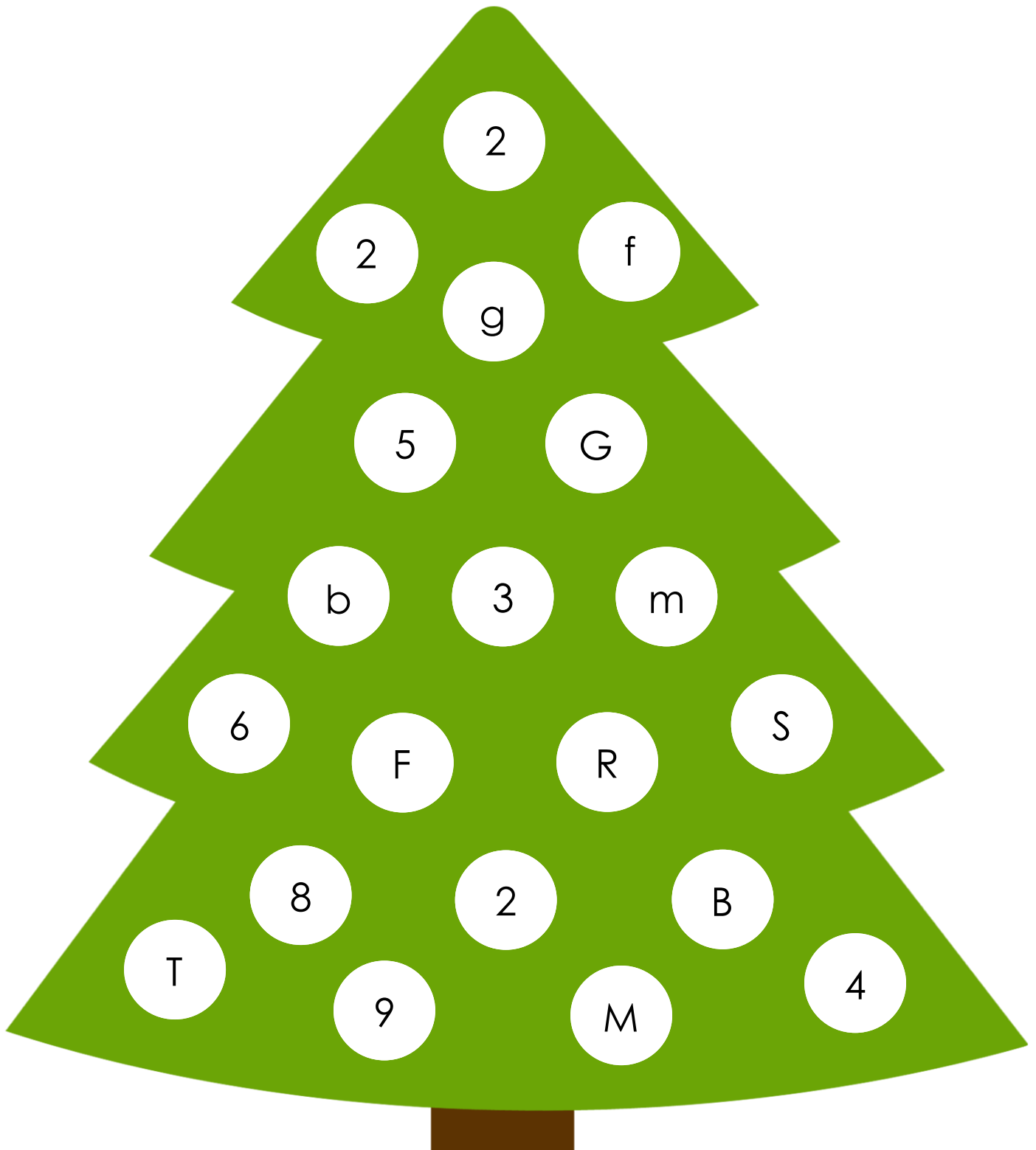
The mouse took the 6th top.

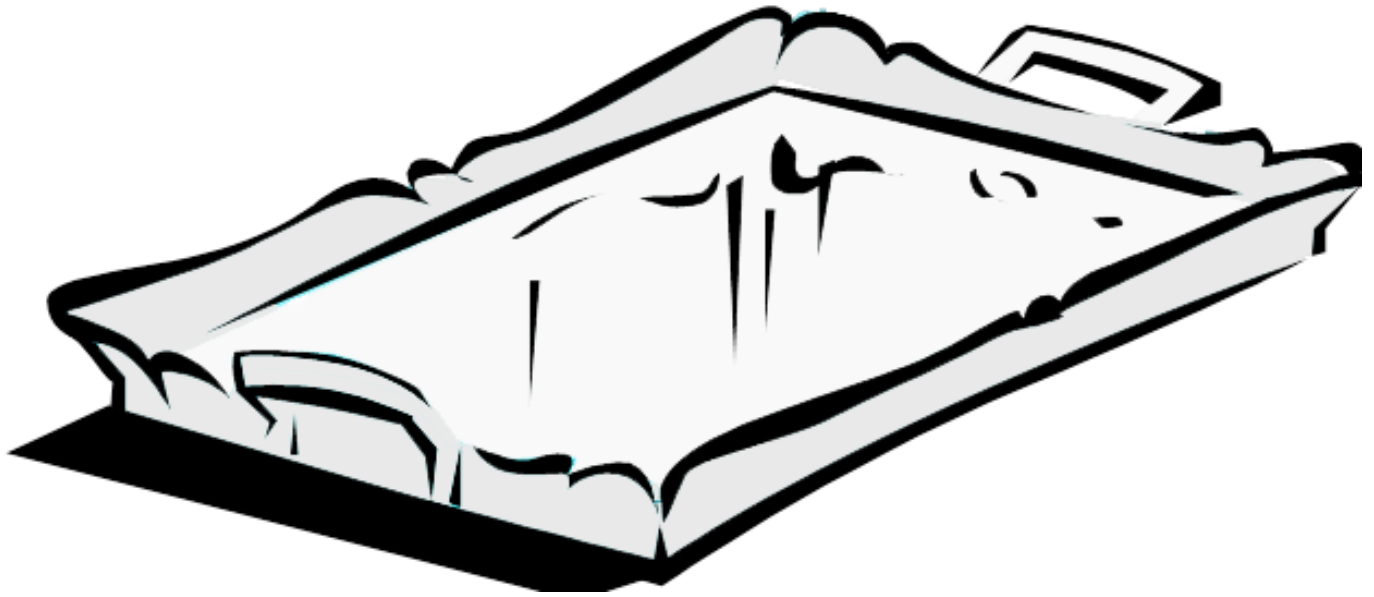


Follow the Directions

4. Draw a red oval around the tree with no ornaments and only a star.

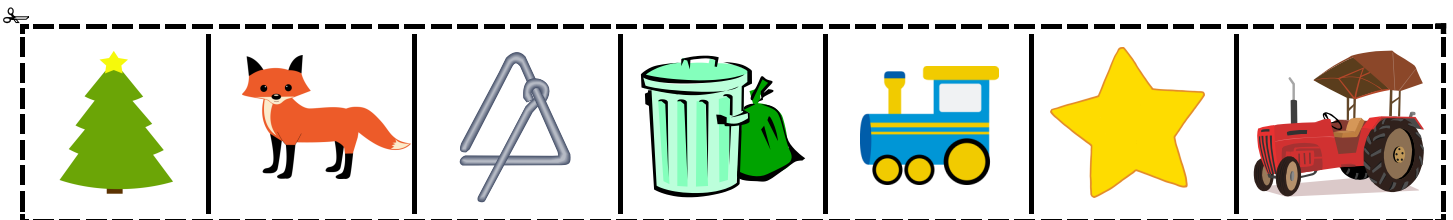
