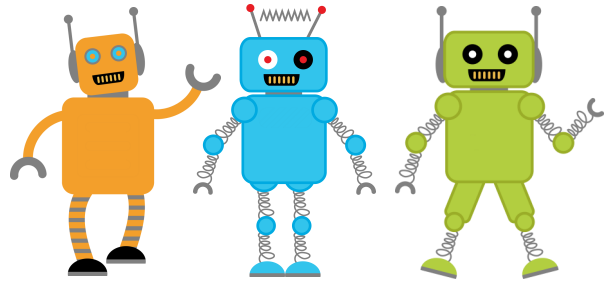


Robot Preschool Pack

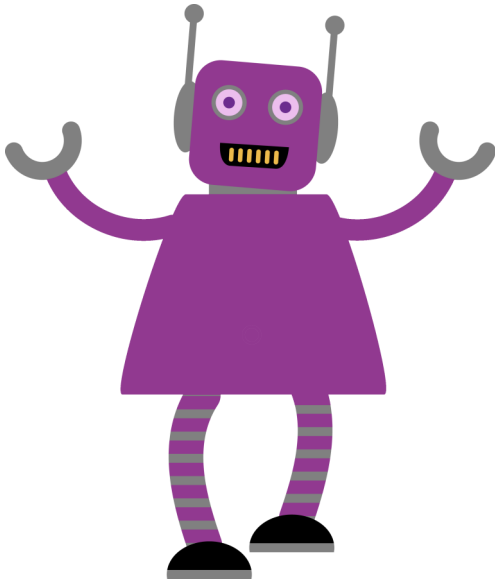
Printables for this preschool pack include:
